Around The Island Race

September 26 & 27, 2015

Eligibility: All yachts with a PHRF rating or equivalent Club rating

Racing Rules: ISAF Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, PMYC 2015 general race instructions as published in the yearbook.

Entry fee: Fifteen Bucks (\$15) this applies to all boats (does not include the \$15 per person fee for Saturday night dinner – see below).

Registration: Please register [online](#) at the PMYC Round The Island Race web page. You will receive the option to pay online or by PayPal within 5 days.

Class breaks: Division 1 = 135 and below. Division 2 = 136 and above. Division 3 = Cruising Class, no flying sails. 3 starts.

Ratings: It is the responsibility of the skipper to provide the race committee with the correct and current PHRF Northwest rating. Skipper shall obtain NFS ratings as modified per PHRF handbook.

Start Time: The first warning will be signaled on or shortly after 10:00 on Saturday and 9:00 on Sunday.

Division General Recall: The sequence will be stopped and the class restarted.

Starting Order: Inverted start sequence: Div. 3, Div. 2, and Div.1 at 5 minute intervals

The Course Saturday – Start line off Point Monroe, Proceed to Bremerton via Agate Pass to finish off Point Herron. Cross the start line off Point Monroe. Round a yellow cylindrical buoy located approx. 300 yards south of the Indianola Pier to port and proceed to Bremerton via Agate Pass to the finish line in the vicinity of Point Herron.

The Course Sunday – Start off Point Herron and proceed to the finish at Point Monroe, leaving the Decatur Reef buoy at Restoration Point to port.

Light Air: The start may be moved along the course in the interests of completing the race. The course may be shortened at any point. An attempt will be made to locate shortened finishes at Points. Notification of shortened course transmitted on Ch 68.

Time Limits: Saturday – 7 hours. Sunday – 6 hours.

Scoring: Times will be cumulative, combining Saturday and Sunday results together.

Trophies for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd and 1st PMYC boat will be awarded at the PMYC annual meeting in Nov. Non club can have trophies mailed to them at the address provided to the RC on the form attached.

Radio: Racers advised to monitor channel 68. Free moorage Friday night, space permitting.

Moorage in Bremerton: A limited number of spaces have been reserved at the marina. Please contact Bremerton Marina to pre-pay your slip.

Moorage will be assigned upon arrival for boats with reservations. Contact “PMYC Race Control” on Channel 68 for assignments. Boats which have failed to pre-pay, please contact the harbor master directly for assignments and pay as soon as possible upon arrival.

Dinner: Dinner will be served from the grill and provided at the Bremerton Marina on the dock tent at 5:30 pm for \$15.00 per person for those registered in advance (\$20 per person collected at the grill).

The following are choices from the grill, please indicate your preference below: Salmon, hamburgers, sausages, hot dogs and chicken. Soft drinks will be provided.

Salad, Condiments and Desert will be provided. Compostable plates and utensils will be available, boats are encouraged to bring their own dishes, glasses and utensils (if you have them aboard).

Hard Stuff: please bring your own booze/beer.
